Farmers Branch Police to participate in DEA Prescription Drug Takeback Day, Saturday

FARMERS BRANCH | Monday, September 21, 2015 ~ The lobby of the Farmers Branch Justice Center will serve as a drop off location for the Drug Enforcement Administration's National Prescription Drug Takeback Day on Saturday, September 26 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Anyone can drop off old medication in the police department lobby during those posted hours.

The DEA will be accepting old prescriptions at locations around the country as part of their annual effort to properly dispose of outdated medications.

The program is an addition to the Farmers Branch Police Department's regular prescription take-back program which operates Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The Farmers Branch Justice Center is located at 3723 Valley View Lane at the corner of Valley View and Marsh Lanes.
